JULIE MATHESON TO SPEAK ABOUT 'DAPs' AT OUR NEXT MEETING

Our next meeting is on **Tuesday April 18 at 7.30pm** at the Mechanics Institute Hall, 20 Meadow Street, Guildford.

With the proposal for a McDonald's behind the Guildford Hotel to be determined by the Metro East Joint Development Assessment Panel (JDAP) the upcoming GA speaker should be of great interest to Guildford.

Subiaco Councillor Julie Matheson is a strong campaigner against DAPs and argues to have democratically elected people make decisions not Ministerial appointees. She ran for office in the recent state election campaign, with community concern over DAPs the catalyst for forming her own party. Ms Matheson will discuss how they DAPs have affected communities across the Perth metro area and how to make an effective deputation to the panel. As a councillor who sits on the DAPs, she has great insight into how they operate. Her main criticism is that DAPs take decision-making powers away from democratically elected local councils and give better appeal rights to developers.

The five-member JDAP panel deciding on the McDonald's application, slated for mid-June, will consist of two City of Swan Councillors and three Ministerial appointees

FACE-LIFT FOR MEMORY GATES

The Association thanks the City of Swan for their recent restoration of the Memory Gates in Stirling Square. Some timbers were badly rotted and the replacement timbers have been lifted into place. The Memory Gates were donated to the Guildford community by the Guildford Municipal Council and unveiled in 1932. These Gates will be ready for the Anzac Day service by the War Memorial.

ANZAC WALK TRAIL

Those who own an Anzac home are encouraged to honour their Anzac with a poppy at the Anzac service. All are encouraged to commemorate Australians who have died as a result of war by following our unique Guildford Anzacs Walk Trail, a self-guided walk highlighting Guildford homes where Anzacs lived. INFORMATION FORUM RE: MCDONALD'S APPLICATION

More than 120 people attended the GA's public meeting/information night to assist people in writing submissions objecting to the McDonald's behind the Guildford Hotel. Speakers included our local member the Hon. Michelle Roberts, anti-DAP campaigner Cr Julie Matheson, Andrea Weston from the Heart Foundation Midland-Guildford ward's Cr Ian Johnson, GA President Ted Williams and Vice President Barbara Dundas. Many thanks to Fran Irwin for chairing the meeting and executive committee member Andrew Kiely for organising.

The following four motions were passed at the meeting:

- The City of Swan's elected Councillors to reclaim responsibility for making decisions on JDAP matters.
- The City of Swan to work with the State Government to register Guildford as a 'heritage precinct'.
- The City of Swan to appoint a fulltime Heritage Officer.
- The City of Swan update their parking figures in relation to the proposed McDonald's planning application.
