## PERTH TREE CANOPY UNDER THREAT

Dominic Castledine of the Department of Agriculture spoke on the threat of the polyphagous Shot Hole Borer at the October meeting. This wood-boring exotic beetle is highly destructive to plants and trees with woody stems of 2cm

and greater. Apart from one caught on a trap in South Guildford, it has not been detected in Guildford. Avoid bringing woody plant matter into the area. This SE Asian beetle has the potential to devastate our local environment. Removal of trees is the only way to stop the spread. So far 1,634 have been removed. Forty plane trees and some figs in Hyde Park have shown signs of infestation. The top five host trees in WA are box elder maple, black locust, coral tree, plane tree and moreton bay fig. #### EXPANSION OF GUILDFORD HOTEL TO FORMER VAUDEVILLE THEATRE

The GA opposed this proposed expansion on the grounds of parking, traffic and flawed process. A submission was made both to Council and the Joint Development Assessment Panel, which granted approval.

St Matthew's church has celebrated 150 years in its current building on Stirling Square – it was rebuilt in 1873 after being destroyed in a hurricane. The occasion was marked with a dinner on October 13 and a special service with Archbishop Kay Goldsworthy on October 14.

Sadly, the number of successful magpie progeny in Guildford has been very limited in the last 5 years. Most family groups studied had no successful progeny for 5 years. Grace asked that residents remember to put out water for wild life in the coming hot months.
