Submissions must be received by **Friday 19 October 2018**.

TREE RESCUE DAY

Following on from the talk by Professor Giles Hardy at the last GA meeting, on the decline of Guildford's flooded gums, there will be a community tree rescue day on Saturday 6 October, 9.30am-12.30pm.

Attendees will be taken on a site tour and receive training on how to inject suitable trees with Phosphite, a biodegradable fungicide that protects plants against dieback, along with a nutrient solution which may help boost tree vigour, enhance defence responses and stimulate root development.

Approximately 10 large trees will be treated and this will be followed by a free bbq. These treatments are safe to apply and all equipment will be supplied. No prior knowledge of how to treat trees is required. Just wear suitable clothing, safety glasses, and bring a water bottle.

A maquette model of the interactive bronze Guildford Light Horse Statue planned for Stirling Square is currently on display at Guildford Library. The statue commemorates the formation of the 10th Light Horse Regiment in Guildford.

The winning maquette, by artist Charles Robb, was unveiled recently at the Foundation Pavilion, Guildford Grammar School, by the Hon. Ken Wyatt MP and the Hon. Michelle Roberts MLA.

The City of Swan has donated \$100,000 towards this magnificent interactive statue, designed to allow children to sit on the horse. Further funds will be provided through public subscription.
